Types of Cannabis Products

Once registered, there are many ways in which patients can begin to incorporate cannabis medicines into their lives.

It is important to consult with a Dispensary Pharmacist before determining which product(s) may be best suited for your symptom(s) and condition(s).

Listed below is a sampling of the options currently offered at our dispensary facility.

Inhalable



The inhalation methods listed below will allow for rapid onset of effects, which can provide relief lasting from 1-4 hours. Controlling the dosage when inhaling cannabis may be easier due to the patient's ability to regulate their intake.

Dried Flower: This product is commonly inhaled upon heating the raw plant material to the point of combustion or vaporization.

Vape Oils: A convenient and discreet method of use, in which patients inhale the vapor created by heating the concentrated oil extracted from the cannabis flower.

Concentrates: These products are highly concentrated oil extracted from the cannabis flower. They are intended to be vaporized and come in a variety of consistencies.

Sublingual



Sublingual preparations typically have an onset time of 15-30 minutes, while providing effects that may last up to 4 hours.

For our patients who require rapid onset of effects and controllability who are unable or unwilling to use inhalable options, sublingual products can be administered under the tongue or inside the cheek. We carry a variety of sublingual options that provide discreet, precise dosing.

During your initial intake appointment, our experienced Dispensary Pharmacists will provide you guidance on appropriate starting dosages and help you decide which method(s) of use may suit your needs best.

Consumable



Onset of effects using consumables may take from 30 minutes to 2 hours, duration of effects may last from 5-8 hours. Patients who require a longer duration of effects may find great benefit from incorporating consumable products into their regimen.

These products are typically used by ingesting prepared cannabis oil infused food items, tablets or pre-filled cannabis oil capsules.

Concentrated Oil Syringes



We also offer oral syringes containing oils that have been extracted from the raw cannabis flower. This option allows for patients to fill their own capsules at home or infuse foods easily on their own.

Topical



Cannabis infused topical products such as lotions, balms, and salves are applied directly to the skin in areas which are painful or inflamed. Topical preparations are intended to deliver local relief at the site of application, while typically not producing a psychoactive effect.

Transdermal

Transdermal options are applied topically but are designed to act as a carrier for cannabinoids to be absorbed through the skin or mucosal membranes instead of by oral or ingestible routes. These are intended to have an effect in areas of the body away from the site of application as well as locally.

Registering for Your Medical Marijuana Card Is as Easy As 1...2....3...

If you qualify for the palliative use of medical marijuana, a Physician or APRN can certify you through the Connecticut Department of Consumer Protection's registration system.

1) Make appointment with a Physician/APRN

Patients must meet with a CT licensed physician, or APRN in good standing, who holds a DEA License Number that is not subject to limitations. This provider must conclude that the patient suffers from at least (1) of the current recognized conditions to qualify for the program.

2) Create Your Online Account

You should then create an account so you can access the online registration system using the email address you gave to your provider at your certification appointment. You will then need to activate the account via a confirmation email, and follow the link to login to your account.

Please carefully review the information that the provider has submitted on your behalf and verify that it is accurate and complete.

3) Submit the Following

- 1 form of Proof of Identity
- 1 form of Proof of CT Residency
