

Registration Assistance

Navigating the Department of Consumer Protection's application for your Medical Marijuana Card can be tricky. That is why we are here to assist you!

For the application you will need to submit a few documents:

- Proof of Identity
- Proof of Connecticut Residency
- \$100 – credit, debit, money order, or check accepted
(Additional \$25 for Caregivers)

After being certified by a physician, come down to our office with your documents and payment— no appointment necessary!



Talk to your physician about getting certified for the State of Connecticut's Medical Marijuana Program!


Patient Support and Education

CBD is a natural molecule that can offer numerous health benefits.

What We Sell:

Cannabidiol (CBD) is a molecule found in the cannabis plant. While THC is the most commonly known molecule associated with cannabis, CBD is non-psychoactive, so you won't get that "high", euphoric feeling. CBD products may offer relief for a wide-range of conditions and their symptoms.

Your body has an endo-cannabinoid system that plays a crucial role in regulating physiology, mood, and every day experience. The CBD molecule reacts with these cannabinoid receptors in your body to alleviate adverse symptoms.

You do not need a Medical Marijuana Card to purchase CBD. We have a few options available for purchase in our office. For patients on the MMJ program, any CBD products purchased at CAS will **NOT** come off your monthly allotment.
